

What a great start to the summer sailing season. Our junior sailing program is off to a great start with approximately 70 juniors between the Learn to Sail, Intro to Racing and Travel Team.

Please note <u>no</u> junior sailing program on July 10 or July 11 due to BYC hosting the Opti South Jersey Championship and the LBIYRA. Monday and Thursday will be regularly scheduled junior programs.

We are making the following changes to the sailing program to take advantage of the vast experience of our instructors and dock hands and build on the sailing abilities of our juniors who are advancing with great strides with so many new juniors entering the racing circuit.

The new schedule beginning ASAP as follows: It will also be posted on the Juniors' board at the Club.

Learn to Sail:

There will be no changes made to this program and your child will continue to come from 9 to 11 AM on either Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.

Advanced Learn to Sail:

All sailors are expected to arrive at 10:30 AM to rig their boats in time for class at 11. Please be considerate of the other sailors and arrive at 10:30 AM, we will not be able to accommodate individual sailors if they come late. We encourage guardians to stick around for the half hour prior to lessons, but we strongly encourage for parents to leave (or pretend to leave) because it tends to cause a great distraction for the sailors as well as the instructors. If your child sails Monday/Wednesday, Wednesday's schedule will remain unchanged but your child will have sailing from 11:00 am until 3pm on Monday. There will be lunch around 12:30 every day so please pack your child a lunch. If your child sails Tuesday/Thursday, Thursday's schedule will remain unchanged but your child will have sailing from 11:00 am until 3pm on Tuesday. There will be lunch around 12:30 every day so please pack your child a lunch. Chef Lisa does serve lunch on Tuesday but you are not required to buy this lunch.

Club Race:

All sailors are expected to arrive at 10:30 am to rig their boats in time for class at 11. All club racers will now sail at the yacht club 11am-3pm on Monday and Tuesday. There will be lunch around 12:30 every day so please pack your child a lunch. Chef Lisa does serve lunch on Tuesday but you are <u>not</u> required to buy this lunch.

420/Laser/Sunfish:

1st year/beginner sailors will now come Monday and Tuesday from 12:30-3pm and advanced sailors will continue to come Wednesday and Thursday from 12:30-3pm. If you have any questions on placement of your child please contact AJ or KayLynn. It is also strongly encouraged that older sailors get their own boat, whether it is a 420, a Laser, or a Sunfish, we have instructors well versed in all three.

We hope that this new schedule pleases all of you and allows your children to have more time on the water and with their friends at the club! We are very excited to have a fun and safe summer sailing with your kids! Also please remember we have club boats available for sailing if siblings who share boats during different times will now sail at the same time.

We kicked off July by hosting the MAYRA midweek regatta on July 5 fielding a team of 15 sailors among a fleet of 110 boats. Close to the biggest turn out ever at BYC for any regatta. Huge thanks to the many volunteers, sailing instructors and dock hands that made the event a huge success. As a reminder to all members the club is staffed 7 days per week with instructors and dockhands to ensure the safety and lend a hand to anyone who needs help launching, rigging and general supervision while on the water. Swimming is still at your own risk and you need to supervise your children and companions should you use the club as your launch to swim.

Sailing lessons are available to all members regardless of your sailing ability and can be scheduled through KayLynn Ford and AJ Carchidi. Any instructor who is level one certified is available for one on one instruction. Lessons are \$20 per hour.

We tried something new this past Friday July 6th with our first ever all women Stand Up Paddle (SUP) relay race. Team Captains included Kelly Cordasco, Carolyn Harris and Elyse Wackerman. 3 teams of 4 women battled hard including some (one) who braved the bay for the first time (name omitted to protect her husband).
