BYC Application process in five simple steps!

1. Contact the membership committee:
 - Take a tour of the clubhouse and grounds; visit the club during a social event or receive information about membership in the Brigantine Yacht Club.

2. Complete and submit this Membership Application:

 - US Post is also acceptable: Brigantine Yacht Club, PO Box 104, Brigantine, NJ 08203
3. Receive a dues and fees quote.
4. Your application is reviewed:
 - When the BYC membership committee has received your complete application:
 - Your sponsoring BYC-member will be contacted for comments.
 - Or, if you do not have a sponsor, the committee will arrange for an interview with you.
 - Your application will be forwarded to the Trustees for a vote and you will receive a notice of their decision.
5. Upon approval:
 - The Treasurer will invoice you for dues and fees. Payment is requested within 14 days.
 - The Corresponding Secretary will enter you in the club Directory.
 - You may use club facilities upon receipt of an official welcome letter.

BYC 2020 Schedule of Annual Dues and Fees

Brigantine Yacht Club adult **dues** are assessed based on the age category of the member. On average, 60% of dues are budgeted for **operating expenses** and 40% goes to **capital improvement** funds for the club's long-term needs.

Adult age 75 and over	\$140	\$135	\$275
Adults 35 to 74 years	\$280	\$210	\$490
Adults 30 to 34 years	\$210	\$120	\$330
Adults 25 to 29 years	\$140	\$30	\$170
Adults 21 to 25 years	\$70	\$15	\$85
Young Adults 18 to 21 years (May join as adult or child)	\$70	\$15	\$85

New adult members are charged a one-time initiation fee of \$400. This fee may be approved for payment over the course of two years if you request this. Initiation fees contribute to BYC's capital improvement fund.

The Brigantine Yacht Club also assesses fees for participation in the sailing program, and for in-water and land storage of member's boats (as capacity allows). Boat storage fees are based on size and type of vessel. Applicants will be referred to the dock committee or the yard committee to assist in calculating these fees.
